## COUNTY, REGION, DISTRICT, SCHOOLS:

The information on Texas public schools is arranged by counties, school districts (with region number following), and schools. Addresses, telephone numbers, and zip code numbers are shown immediately following the county and school district. The numbers in parentheses preceding the telephone number denotes the area code. School names are listed within these categories: High School (HS), Junior High School (JH), Intermediate School (INT), Middle School (MIDDLE), Elementary (EL), and Primary (PRI).
