# Texas Public Schools and Charters, Explanation of Symbols and Terms

# County, District, Region, School

The information on Texas public schools is arranged by counties, school districts (with education service center [ESC] region number following), and schools. Addresses, telephone numbers, and zip codes are shown immediately following the counties and school districts.

# **County-District-School Number**

These columns show the identification numbers used by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) for Texas counties, school districts, and schools. The counties of the state are numbered from 1 through 254 in alphabetical order. In 2009-10, there were 1,267 educational entities with TEA-assigned school district numbers.

TEA-assigned school numbers are unique identification numbers only; they do not denote school types (e.g., elementary school, junior high school, high school). Schools are numbered from 001 through 698. Schools are categorized as: regular instructional; alternative instructional; juvenile justice alternative education program instructional (JJAEP); disciplinary alternative education program instructional (DAEP); charter/regular instructional; charter/alternative instructional; charter/JJAEP instructional; or charter/DAEP instructional.

#### **County and District Superintendents, Principals**

The names of county superintendents, district superintendents, and school principals are shown opposite the administrative units they supervise. County superintendents whose names carry an asterisk (\*) are ex-officio superintendents.

#### Grades

This column shows grade levels taught, including early education (EE), prekindergarten (PK), kindergarten (KG), and ungraded (UG).

### **Enrollment**

This column shows the fall 2008 enrollment for each school district and school. If the school configuration for a district changed for the 2009-10 school year, the school counts may not add to the district total. Revised school configurations for 2009-10 are received in the summer of 2009. When enrollment is fewer than five students or could be imputed from district totals, the count is masked with a dash (–) to protect student anonymity.

# **Appraised Valuation and Tax Rates**

Appraised valuation is in thousands. Tax rates are per \$100 of appraised valuation. Values are those reported by districts in their 2008-09 official budgets.

# **Additions of School Districts**

**Dallas County (057).** ESC Region 10. Effective February 26, 2009, Manara Academy became a new charter school district. The official name is Manara Academy (CDN 057-844).

**Jefferson County (123).** ESC Region 5. Effective March 19, 2009, Bob Hope School became a new charter school district. The official name is Bob Hope School (CDN 123-807).

**Tom Green County (226).** ESC Region 15. Effective January 23, 2009, TLC Academy became a new charter school district. The official name is TLC Academy (CDN 226-801).

**Travis County (227).** ESC Region 13. Effective February 26, 2009, the East Austin College Prep Academy became a new charter school district. The official name is the East Austin College Prep Academy (CDN 227-824).

#### **Deletions of School Districts**

**Dallas County (057).** Effective February 25, 2009, Lynacre Academy Charter School (CDN 057-818) was obsoleted as a reporting charter school district.

**Ward County (238).** Effective August 11, 2009, West Texas State School (CDN 238-905) was obsoleted as a reporting district.

**Ector County (068).** Effective February 25, 2009, Richard Milburn Academy (Ector County) (CDN 068-801) consolidated with Richard Milburn Academy (Midland County) (CDN 165-801). The official name is Richard Milburn Academy (Ector County) (CDN 068-801).
