

Texas Public Schools and Charters, Explanation of Symbols and Terms

County, District, Region, School

The information on Texas public schools is arranged by counties, school districts (with education service center [ESC] region number following), and schools. Addresses, telephone numbers, and zip codes are shown immediately following the counties and school districts.

County-District-School Number

These columns show the identification numbers used by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) for Texas counties, school districts, and schools. The counties of the state are numbered from 1 through 254 in alphabetical order. In 2014-15, there were 1,246 educational entities with TEA-assigned school district numbers.

TEA-assigned school numbers are unique identification numbers only; they do not denote school types (e.g., elementary school, junior high school, high school). Schools are numbered from 001 through 698. Schools are categorized as: regular instructional; alternative instructional; juvenile justice alternative education program instructional (JJAEP); disciplinary alternative education program instructional (DAEP); charter/regular instructional; charter/alternative instructional; charter/JJAEP instructional; or charter/DAEP instructional.

County and District Superintendents, Principals

The names of county superintendents, district superintendents, and school principals are shown opposite the administrative units they supervise.

Grades

This column shows grade levels taught, including early education (EE), prekindergarten (PK), kindergarten (KG), and ungraded (UG).

Enrollment

This column shows the fall 2013 enrollment for each school district and school. If the school configuration for a district changed for the 2014-15 school year, the school counts may not add to the district total. Revised school configurations for 2014-15 are received in the summer of 2014. When enrollment is fewer than five students or could be imputed from district totals, the count is masked with a dash (–) to protect student anonymity.

Appraised Valuation and Tax Rates

Appraised valuation is in thousands. Tax rates are per \$100 of appraised valuation. Values are those reported by districts in their 2013-14 official budgets.

Additions of School Districts

Bexar County (015). Education Service Center (ESC) Region 20. Effective February 25, 2014, CARPE DIEM SCHOOLS became a new charter school district. The official name is CARPE DIEM SCHOOLS (County-District Number [CDN] 015-837).

Ector County (068). ESC Region 18. Effective March 19, 2014, UTPB STEM ACADEMY became a new charter school district. The official name is UTPB STEM ACADEMY (CDN 068-803).

Travis County (227). ESC Region 13. Effective December 5, 2013, MONTESSORI FOR ALL became a new charter school district. The official name is MONTESSORI FOR ALL (CDN 227-826).

Effective March 20, 2014, THE EXCEL CENTER became a new charter school district. The official name is THE EXCEL CENTER (CDN 227-827).

Webb County (240). ESC Region 01. Effective April 22, 2014, TEXAS A&M INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY ISD became a new district. The official name is TEXAS A&M INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY ISD (CDN 240-503).

Deletions of School Districts

Harris County (101). Effective March 4, 2014, ALPHONSO CRUTCH'S-LIFE SUPPORT CENTER (CDN 101-817) was obsoleted as a reporting charter school district.

Consolidations of School Districts

Bexar County (015). Effective March 4, 2014, SAN ANTONIO CAN HIGH SCHOOL (CDN 015-817) consolidated with TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804). The official name is TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804).

Harris County (101). Effective March 4, 2014, HOUSTON CAN ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL (CDN 101-812) consolidated with TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804). The official name is TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804).

Effective March 4, 2014, KIPP SOUTHEAST HOUSTON (CDN 101-860) consolidated with KIPP INC CHARTER (CDN 101-813). The official name is KIPP INC CHARTER (CDN 101-813).

Tarrant County (220). Effective March 4, 2014, FORT WORTH CAN ACADEMY (CDN 220-804) consolidated with TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804). The official name is TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804).

Travis County (227). Effective March 4, 2014, AUSTIN CAN ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL (CDN 227-818) consolidated with TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804). The official name is TEXANS CAN ACADEMIES (CDN 057-804).
